The election will be conducted by mail. In order to maintain ballot control and election tally accuracy, ballots MUST be returned by mail using the envelope provided in the ballot package. Ballots submitted in any other manner will not be accepted.

It is very important for all participants to remember no government or union resources can be used for candidate campaigns, including copiers, paper, office space, telephone, cell phone, bulletin boards, computer equipment, or email ID. Campaign literature cannot be posted on walls or bulletin boards, nor shared by way of a desk drop.

Per AFGE Local 2152 Constitution and bylaws, the election committee was elected at the March monthly membership meeting.

Nomination Meeting

Nominations for the offices of President, Executive Vice President, 2nd VP for Title 5 Employees, 2nd VP for Title 38 Professional Employees, Secretary, Treasurer, five Delegates, and two alternate delegates will be accepted from the floor at the Nomination meeting.

The meeting will be held:

Time and Date: 5:00 PM PDT on May 02, 2018

Place: Tahoe Room at VASNHCS at 975 Kirman Avenue, Reno, NV

A second for a nomination is not required. Self nominations are permissible.

Nominations also may be made by email to the election committee and must be received no later than 5:00 PM PDT on May 02, 2018.

Qualifications for office are: be a member in good standing, be a member of an AFGE local for one year immediately preceding the closing of nominations on May 02, 2018, and must not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO.

A candidate must accept or decline nomination if present at the nomination meeting. Any nominee not present is required to email a written acceptance to the election committee no later than 5:00 PM PDT on May 03, 2018.

The member making the nomination has the responsibility of informing the nominee of his or her nomination.

Election Meeting

Ballots will be mailed to the last known address of each member on May 21, 2018. To ensure ballot control and election tally accuracy, completed ballots must be mailed in the return address envelope provided. Ballots submitted in any other manner will not be accepted. Ballots will be collected from the Post Office at 12:00 PM PDT on June 20, 2018.

Local 2152 members are eligible to vote if their dues are current or if their signed dues withholding form was accepted by a responsible officer of the local prior to 5:00 PM PDT on May 02, 2018.

Each candidate may have a reasonable number of observers, who are members, present during the collection and tallying of ballots. Candidates must declare the name of any election observers to the election committee by email no later than 5:00 PM PDT on May 07, 2018.

Newly elected officers will be installed at the monthly membership meeting at 5:00 PM PDT on June 20, 2018.

All protests to the election must be received by the election committee by email prior to, during, or within ten days after the election.

This election is governed by the AFGE Rules of Conduct for an Election, set forth in Appendix A of the AFGE National Constitution.
